

## FISH PAVEMENT, HULL

Andrew Knight curated and project managed the 'Fish Pavement', commissioned for sites along Hull's City Trail – a visual A-Z of sea life, from anchovy to zander. Gordon Young's ideas developed from who now knows just Cod, Haddock or Monkfish actually look like? Images, life size, from Anchovy to Zander, were produced in a variety of materials including low relief carvings, cast bronze, imprinted brick and inset lead. Their locations often introduce a gentle sense of fun into the public realm, a Monkfish on Whitefriargate or a Brill patiently waiting at the bus stop.

In 2009 Graham Roberts organised the commissioning of three new fish.
